



# The Process of a FrontLine Build



## Step 1

We receive referrals from our partners who have identified an individual that would best fit our program and we have them submit an application.

## Step 2

Once the application has been submitted, our board reviews the submission and decides whether to accept the application.

## Step 3

Once the application has been accepted, we schedule a home visit to assess the size of the yard and discuss wants, needs, and how we can achieve this for our applicant.

## Step 4

We work to identify sponsors and donors in the direct community to support material costs and then utilize our own funds for the rest if necessary.

## Step 5

We work on getting a group of volunteers together for the build based on needs and if our applicant is a part of any groups in their community.

## Step 6

We purchase compost and any other materials left for the build, search for a food donor for volunteers, and schedule the build!

## Step 7

Build Day!  
We work together with our volunteers to build a garden for our applicant. Each applicant is left with a beautiful new garden and a basket of goodies including a commemorative military plaque to solidify completion of the build and the significance behind it.
